This declaration is issued under the sole responsibility of the manufacturer. The product described above complies with the following directives and standards:

REACH

We hereby declare that the product described above complies with the requirements of the **REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006** concerning the registration, evaluation, authorization, and restriction of chemicals.

Specifically:

- No substances on the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) are present in the product above the threshold limits (0.1% w/w).
- The product does not contain restricted substances beyond the allowed limits as per Annex XVII of REACH.
- All necessary registration and notifications under REACH have been completed by the manufacturer and/or suppliers.
- The product is safe for its intended use under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.

EU regulation 2017/821 (concerning due diligence in supply chain for importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten and gold)

The product we manufacture does not contain conflict minerals (tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold – 3TG) sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups.

- Does not contain intentionally added PFAS substances (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) exceeding applicable regulatory limits.
- Complies with all relevant PFAS restrictions under applicable regulations, including but not limited to:
 - o EU REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, Annex XVII (restrictions on certain PFAS).
 - o EU Persistent Organic Pollutants (POP) Regulation (EU) 2019/1021.
 - o Relevant national legislation restricting PFAS usage.

RoHS 2002/95/EC (restriction of hazardous Substances)

We hereby declare that the products described above is in full conformity with the requirements of the RoHS directive 2011/65/EU.

PPWR 2025/40 (Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation)

All packaging materials and products supplied by Axelent comply with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR).

Specifically, we confirm compliance with:

- Substance restrictions, including heavy metal limits and restrictions on PFAS.
- Requirements for packaging minimization (weight and volume optimization) and design for recycling.
- Applicable labelling, marking, and information requirements.

EUDR 2023/1115 (EU Deforestation free Regulation)

Rubber-based components used in Axelent AB products are produced exclusively from synthetic rubber materials, such as EPDM (Ethylene-Propylene-Diene Monomer), PUR (Polyurethane), and other petrochemical-based elastomers.

These materials are classified under HS codes such as 4002, 4008, and 4016, all of which correspond to synthetic or petrochemically derived rubber articles, and not natural rubber.

The EUDR applies solely to natural rubber classified under HS code 4001. Since Axelent AB does not use natural rubber in the components referenced above, these materials fall outside the regulatory scope of EUDR.

Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

Axelent does not manufacture, import, process, distribute or otherwise use any chemical substances that fall under the jurisdiction of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) of the United States.
